Dog Bite Case

Based on the information provided by the Sheriff's Office, the Board unanimously approved a **MOTION** to appropriate General Reserve Funds to pay for the vet bill (\$100.00) in a dog bite case.

County's Mileage Rate

Clerk Smith advised the Board that the State is currently using a 50.5 cents/mile reimbursement rate for business mileage. Pursuant to their standing policy, the Board unanimously approved a **MOTION** to increase the County's mileage rate of

reimbursement to 50.5 cents effective June 1, 2008 and future increases to be effective the first of the month following future state increases.

Weed Control Problems

Richard Garrard, County Agent for Cassia County, met with the Board to discuss weed problems in both counties on CREP ground. There will be a tour of several problem areas on June 11 and Commissioner Stapelman will attend.

Tax Deed Hearing

Assessor Vaughn met with the Board to present the contract for BDS (Billing Document Specialists) to print and mail out the 2008 Assessment Notices. The Board unanimously approved a **MOTION** to approve the contract.

Primary Election Results

Clerk Smith presented the Board with the results of the Primary Election. He reviewed the steps involved in: The preparation prior to the Election; Election Day activities; and the counting of the ballots. He also discussed the problem that caused the delay in finalizing the count. The Board canvassed the results and approved the final vote count.
