Request for Cancellation of Taxes

Roy Maldonado met with the Board to request the cancellation of taxes on property owned by the Rivers of Life Ministries. The Board had previously approved their tax exemption status for 2008, however the past due taxes were not addressed. The Board unanimously approved a **MOTION** to approve his Request for Tax Cancellation.

South Central Community Action Partnership

Ken Robinette, representing South Central Community Action Partnership, met with the Board to review their past year's activities and to present his request for funding for their 2009 Budget.

Moratorium on Older Mobile Homes

Prosecuting Attorney Cannon discussed her recommendation for a moratorium on older mobile homes coming into the County. She advised that an “interim” moratorium would be better than an “emergency” moratorium to allow time to develop an ordinance for such regulation.

Complaint Against Neighbor for Trash

Eva Jackson appeared before the Board to voice her concerns about the nuisance created by her neighbor allowing the collection of trash on their property. Zoning Administrator Aston and Prosecutor cannon reviewed what they have done in the past to address that particular situation. Cannon indicated that she will pursue legal action. The Board unanimously passed a **MOTION** authorizing Prosecutor cannon to proceed with a civil suit against Jerry Loveless to remedy the problem.

Resolution 08-01

Community Development Administrator Aston presented Resolution 08-01 for the board’s approval. The resolution stated the County’s support of The Community Building Code Administration Grant Act of 2007. The Board unanimously approved a **MOTION** to adopt the Resolution.
