Electronic Copies Fee Schedule

Assessor Vaughn met with the Board to discuss a fee schedule for electronic copies of his data base. The Board agreed to proceed with noticing a hearing as soon as he develops a fee schedule.

Noise Ordinance Discussion

Larry, Joetta, and Roy Abo appeared before the Board to discuss the need for a noise ordinance. Their neighbor recently constructed several grain bins near the Abo's home and the noise of the fans is becoming a nuisance. Community Development Administrator Aston advised the Abos that the County has no noise ordinance and pointed out the difficulty of enforcing such an ordinance.

Designate Newspaper for County's Legal Notices

Clerk Smith advised the Board that with the demise of the South Idaho Press, it is now necessary to designate a new newspaper for the publication of the County's legal notices. A **MOTION** was unanimously approved designating The Times-News as the County "OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER".
