Dispatch Agreement City of Heyburn

Sheriff Halverson and Deputy Kindig met with the Board to discuss the proposed agreement with the City of Heyburn to provide dispatch services. Halverson also informed the Board the E-911 is getting ready to handle Phase 2 which will allow dispatch to identify the location of cell phone callers.

Courthouse Remodel
