The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stapelman with Commissioners Hunsaker and Moore in attendance. Minutes were taken by Clerk Smith.

This Special Meeting was scheduled for the purpose of hearing appeals of property valuations. Two hearings were scheduled and one of those appeals was withdrawn.

A MOTION to convene as the Board of Equalization was unanimously approved. Appearing before the Board was J. Berkeley Orton. He was requesting that his assessed valuation of \$ 509,072, which the Assessor's Office had already lowered to \$ 486,512, be reduced to \$ 410,000. He felt there were no sales of comparable properties to support the assessed valuation. The Assessor's Office presented their documentation supporting the valuation that they had assessed. The Board unanimously approved a MOTION to deny Mr. Orton's appeal.

Assessor Vaughn presented valuation adjustments for Clyde Gillespie/Sue Bosted and the Hellewell Estate properties that the Board approved. The Board had further discussion on Jake Raiton's appeal of the Maverik property.

Having no further business to come before the Board of Equalization, the Board reconvened as the Board of County Commissioners.

A MOTION was unanimously approved to cancel the \$ 130.00 Solid Waste Fees for Don Hellewell and Julia Gumm.

A MOTION to go into Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code Section 67-2345(1b) was unanimously approved. The general tenor of the session was a discussion of a personnel matter with Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson. Returning to Regular

Session the Board unanimously approved a MOTION placing a public official on probation with restricted access to financial matters.

Having no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
