Marty Van Tassell, Minidoka County Highway District commissioner, met with the Board to discuss the county’s “Water on the Roadways” Ordinance 92-3. Also in

Roy Belnap, Chairman of the Soil & Water Conservation District, reviewed the past year's activities and presented their request for funding for FY2010. He mentioned their Board has been completely overhauled and the new members joining him are John Firth, Wilbert Caddy, and Mark Harrison. The Board unanimously approved a MOTION to issue their normal Letter of Intent for \$3,500.
