



## MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

January 6, 2020

The meeting was opened at 8:30 AM with **The Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.**

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk was present via telephone, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Clerk Page.

### **Applications for County Aid:**

2019-135 Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the medically necessary charges with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried. Reimbursement will be decided when the medical review has been finalized.

2019-138 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as applicant failed to cooperate with the county, is in the state for temporary purposes and therefore we are not the obligated county and he is not a resident, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-139 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as applicant failed to cooperate with County and therefore there is insufficient information to determine residency, obligated county, last resource, and medical indigency with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-140 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as applicant failed to provide information to Medicaid and County, we do not know if we are the last resource and applicant needs to follow through with Health & Welfare. Due to the applicant failing to cooperate with the county, there is insufficient evidence and/or a lack of proof to determine residency, obligated county, last resource, and medical indigency. No medical bills or records are on file and therefore unknown as to the medical necessity or emergency of the visit, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-141 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as there was no interview with the county, there is insufficient evidence and/or lack of proof to determine residency, obligated county, last resource, and medical indigency, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-144 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as there was no interview with the county, there is insufficient evidence and/or lack of proof to determine residency, obligated county, medical necessity and emergency for the knee surgery, last resource, and medical indigency, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-146 Commissioner Koyle moved to approve with an order waiving reimbursement but keeping the lien in tact with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-145 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as we are not the last resource, the applicant can receive Medicaid if he provides paystubs under workers with disabilities, and due to the applicant failing to cooperate with the county, there is insufficient evidence and/or a lack of proof to determine medical indigency, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2019-143 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as the applicant is not medically indigent and we are not the last resource. If approved at a later date a medical review will be performed. Commissioner Schenk voiced a second. Motion carried.

**No minutes were available** for approval.

Bill Jones, **IT Dept.**, was unavailable for an update.

Tye Thomson, **Buildings and Grounds Admin.**, presented before the Board and gave a report on grounds, snow removal. He will be setting cabinets this week. The generator is being serviced. He spoke about the grounding and the spike protection for our servers – need the carpet removed. Tye will be on vacation the 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> through the 20<sup>th</sup>. Tye inquired of how to handle snow removal while he is gone.

Sheriff Snarr, Yolany Torres, and Angelica Cruz, presented a **resolution to destroy records** from the Driver's License Department, concealed weapons, and sex offender records. Commissioner Koyle moved to approve resolution 2020-01-06 A authorizing the destruction of records with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Sheriff Snarr stated that Richard Koyle is going to retire on the 31<sup>st</sup>. He requested to give Koyle's gun and badge to Koyle at his retirement party. Commissioner Schenk moved to declare Richard Koyle's **gun and badge as surplus property to give to him upon his retirement** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve resolution 2020-01-06 B **authorizing the destruction of Minidoka County Clerk office files** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Amber Prewitt, Misd. Probation Admin., presented before the Board to bring to their attention orders received from Judges regarding **pre-trial release costs**. This impacts revenue and expenditures where last year 80 people were on pre-trial and this year 143 people are on pre-trial release programs to date.

Commissioner Schenk moved to **ratify and award the bid to Peterson Brothers for the solid waste improvements** at our transfer station for \$125,000 as the lowest responsible bidder. A second was voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to pay **payroll and claims** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

**Clerk Page gave her report.**

**Commissioners gave their report.**

**Correspondence was reviewed** from Idaho Power regarding settlement on Hells Canyon waters.

Commissioner Koyle moved to adjourn with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried at 11:41 AM.
