COMMISSIONER MEETING  
MINUTES

January 15, 2019

The purpose of this special meeting was to attend and listen to a court scheduled pretrial conference for case CR-34-2018-3664 at 11 AM in the Sherman J. Bellwood Judicial Building, Magistrate Court, courtroom number 2.

The previously stated pretrial conference was vacated prior to such time. However, the Board convened in a meeting room in the adjacent building to discuss the parameters of the case with Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Rob Hemsley.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Hemsley, Planning and Zoning Admin. Brett Stephens, and Clerk Page.

Members of the public present were: Bob Moore, Alan Albrecht, and Harry Albrecht.

Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Hemsley gave a verbal overview of options available for the court process and a realization of what the most likely outcome would be. Brett Stephens explained what a special use permit is and why it would be used along with the remedy for not having such. Bob Moore stated that he would like to see a civil suit filed against the defendant on behalf of the County. Mr. Hemsley stated that he would relay the request to his boss, that a jury trial is set for April 23, 2019, that he gave an option to admit and comply by the end of June, and that a status hearing is set for February 19, 2019.
