



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

January 31, 2022

The meeting was opened with the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer at 8:30 A.M.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Schenk by phone, Commissioner Koyle entered the meeting at 8:36 a.m., Deputy Prosecutor Goodman, Deputy Clerk McCall, Deputy Clerk Ramsey, and Clerk Page.

Applications for County Aid:

2021-77 Commissioner McClellan moved to deny due to applicant failing to cooperate with the county so there is insufficient evidence and/or a lack of proof to determine last resource and medical indigency with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioners signed findings of fact, conclusions of law and decision for the two cases 2021-36 and 2021-45 that were denied at the appeal hearing last week.

Commissioner Koyle **moved to sign the letter of support for the T-Mobile grant application** to be submitted by the Historical Society/Museum with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner McClellan **moved to sign the One America Insurance subscription agreement** for short- and long-term insurance with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk commented on the legislative changes that are being considered that would affect the circuit breaker program.


Commissioner Koyle reported on building lots and homes listed for sale on MLS for both counties and the price ranges for each category.
