



## MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

February 20, 2020

The meeting was opened at 9:11 AM with The Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan and Commissioner Koyle, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Clerk Page. Commissioner Schenk was excused.

Bob Moore presented before the Board, as a member of the public, to give a history of the promise and hope of buildings out at the fair grounds and museum area.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve claims and payroll** with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve the four Certificates of Residency** with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Clerk Page reviewed Cassia County's request to pay or help pay for a mental hold that may or may not have been a Minidoka County resident. Commissioner Koyle moved that we are **not** inclined to help **pay for the mental hold** as it appears that the individual is not our resident with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Open meeting laws were discussed.

Commissioner Koyle moved to enter into Executive Session pursuant to I.C. 74-206 (1) (f) and I.C. 74-206 (1) (c) with second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. An aye was voiced by Commissioner Koyle. An aye was voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried. Commissioner Koyle moved to exit executive session with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle **moved** that **if our second conflict defenders can not obtain reimbursement** from the Public Defense Commission, then Minidoka County will reimburse up to half of the \$175 registration and up to half of \$225 for per diem costs. Minidoka County will require a Public Defense Commission rejection notification to be submitted to Minidoka County along with proof of attendance. A second was voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved **to approve and sign the support letter** for the Minidoka Soil and Water Conservation District with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned with the tap of the gavel at 10:43 AM.
