



MINIDOKA COUNTY
SPECIAL COMMISSIONER MEETING
MINUTES

April 13, 2022

Meeting location was at Cassia County Commissioner Room.

The meeting was opened with the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer at 9:00 A.M.

Present for this meeting were: Minidoka County Commissioner Schenk, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner McClellan, Prosecutor Stephenson, Deputy Clerk Ramsey, Cassia County Commissioner Searle, Commissioner Beck, Commissioner Kunau, Clerk Larsen, Deputy Clerk Evans, Coroner Rinehart, Undersheriff Thompson, Sheriff Warrell, Administrator McCurray and Deputy Clerk Velasquez.

Prosecutor Larsen called an executive session, Commissioner Searle **moved to go into executive session** pursuant to Idaho code 74-206 1(i), 1(d) and (1)(f), with a second voiced by Commissioner Kunau. Roll call was taken. Commissioner Kunau voiced aye, Commissioner Searle voiced aye, Commissioner Beck voiced aye. Motion carried. Commissioner McClellan **moved to go into executive session** pursuant to Idaho code 74-206 1(i), 1(d) and (1)(f), with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Roll call was taken. Commissioner Koyle voiced aye, Commissioner Schenk voiced aye, Commissioner McClellan voiced aye. Motion carried. Boards exited executive session at 9:25 A.M.

Discussion was held on recruiting and retention at the Mini Cassia Criminal Justice Center. Commissioner Schenk made a motion to make available \$141,000 for recruiting and retention to run through October 1, 2022. Discussion was held on allowing the jail the flexibility to apply the money where needed. With a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Commissioner Kunau made a motion to make \$141,000 available for funding and leave recruiting flexibility to the Mini Cassia Criminal Justice Center, with a second voiced by Commissioner Searle. Motion carried.

Legislative dinner in Boise was discussed with an agreement that the dinner in December was very helpful.

Cassia County Coroner presented to the Cassia County Commissioners the rental of a building and cooler storage at the same location of the Minidoka County Coroner. Commissioner Beck asked Prosecutor Stevenson to draft a contract.

Minidoka County Commissioner adjourned at 11:00 A.M.
