

MINUTES
Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center Committee Meeting
MAY 10, 2022
8:00 A.M.

The meeting was called to order by Prosecutor Stevenson at 8:00 A.M.

Minidoka County representatives present were: Commissioner McClellan, Sheriff Pinther, and Prosecutor Stevenson.

Cassia County representatives present were: Commissioner Searle, Prosecutor Larson and Undersheriff Thompson.

Others present were: Director Renz, Director Prewitt via phone call, Cassia County Deputy Clerk Wallace, JDC Director Bodily, Minidoka Deputy Clerk Ramsey and Minidoka County Clerk Page.

Commissioner McClellan **moved to approve the minutes of April 26, 2022**, with a second voiced by Undersheriff Thompson. Motion carried.

Criminal Justice Center – Director Renz

Director Renz reported that they have 145 in custody: 47 Cassia, 41 Minidoka, 39 IDOC, 14 US Marshals, 2 Twin Falls, which makes 55 beds rented.

Commissioner Searle made a motion to conditionally approve Richard Sammons, with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Director Renz reported that Dr. Wright, the current dental provider, asked for a new contract. Prosecutor Stevenson asked for a copy of the old one and he will work on it. Sawtooth Medical is the current medical provider and they are on a 2-year contract and would like just a cost of living update.

Director Renz reported on a flood that took place at the jail, the fire suppression system had a pipe burst. ICRMP has been notified and had an adjuster come out. They are getting it cleaned up with very minimal damage.

Adult Misdemeanor Probation – Director Prewitt

Director Prewitt reported: They have 1053 active probationers with 372 on pretrial release. She reported that Averhealth has a price increase due to shipping costs, from

\$6.00 to \$6.95 per UA, she will send the new agreement to send out to Prosecutors and Administrator McMurray to get approved. Discussion was held on the different drug testing they do and the different price, Amber would like to have just one price of \$14.00

Juvenile Detention Center – Director Bodily

Director Bodily reported that they have 9 residents, 4 Minidoka, 4 Cassia1 and 1 Twin Falls. He reported that he will be sending a renewal on the MOA with IDJC to the Board of County Commissioners.

Criminal Justice Center Budget – Clerk Larsen

Deputy Clerk Wallace reported that at 60 % of the year gone: Misdemeanor Probation expenditures are at 55% and revenue is looking great; jail expenditures are at 58% and revenue is at 43.56%, with the jail trust at \$89,920.50. Director Renz reported that they have billed \$206,451 for February and March that has not been received yet.

Juvenile Detention Center Budget – Clerk Page

Clerk Page reported that Juvenile Detention is at 50% expended at 60% of the year gone, with \$225,841 in the account. Housing money is all the revenue they bring in and that is at \$1,875.00.
