



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

May 24, 2019

The meeting was opened at 8:30 AM. The pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a prayer.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, Clerk Page, and Deputy Clerk Dockstader.

Juvenile Detention Administrator Trent Bodily presented his **budget request** for FY2020.

Commissioner Koyle moved to exit as the Board of County Commissioners and enter into the Board of Canvassers pursuant to I.C. 34-1205, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

The **Board of Canvassers** reviewed the number of votes presented by Clerk Page. Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the election results for the City of Burley Library Override Levy for the special election held on May 21, 2019, in the Emerson precinct, with 6 votes in favor of and 12 votes against. Commissioner McClellan called for a vote and all voiced aye. Motion carried. Commissioner Schenk motioned to approve the election results for Minidoka School District # 331 Special Obligation School Bond for May 21, 2019, with 1,006 votes in favor of and 846 votes against including Cassia County, Jerome County, and Lincoln County votes, with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Commissioner McClellan moved to exit the Board of County Canvassers with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

The following **appeals of Denials for County Assistance** were heard:

2019-20: This appeal was set to be heard at 9:11 AM.

Present for this hearing were Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Alan Goodman, Welfare Director Cassie Dockstader, Minidoka Memorial Hospital County Coordinator Josie Garcia, Ann Taylor, Attorney for Minidoka Memorial Hospital, the applicant and her daughter-in-law and grand-daughter. Testimony was given.

Commissioner Schenk moved to deny the appeal because she is not indigent and Minidoka County is not the last resource. Commissioner Koyle voiced a second. Motion carried.

2018-138 & 2019-12: This appeal was set to be heard at 9:47 AM.

The applicant is deceased. The appellant was not present. No motions were made at this time due to previous negotiations between the Deputy Prosecuting Attorney and St. Luke's attorney. An approval will be written up for the medically necessary dates of service up to the point of stabilization. Hearing adjourned.

Prosecuting Attorney Lance Stevenson **discussed salaries** of various departments. No motions were made.

This meeting was adjourned with the tap of the gavel at 10:05 AM.
