



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

June 1, 2020

The meeting was opened at 8:30 AM with **The Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.**

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Schenk, Commissioner Koyle, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, Clerk Page and Deputy Clerk McCall.

2020-18 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as no interview so therefore lack of proof to determine residency, obligated county, last resource, and medical indigency, and Emergency Medicaid still pending with a second by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Covid-19 update: thermometers have come in, discussed ordering laptops for commissioners. No action taken.

Clerk Page gave her weekly report: NACO scholarship applications online; Judge interviews at Wilson Theater on June 5; Judge Holloway booked for month of June to cover Judge Bollar's docket; discussed Judge Bollar's county email address; will have historical society newsletter posted on the county website. Board of Equalization will be starting soon, deadline for applications is 5:00 p.m. on June 22th, and has to be concluded July 13th. Commissioners called Assessor West to get her input for hearing dates, would like to get done as soon as possible and would like to come to a resolution before hearings are scheduled. Commissioners set dates and times for Board of Equalization. The joint powers budget hearings will be held June 8th and June 15th. Other Department head budget hearings will be held on June 8 and completed on June 15th. On June 3, our current election system will be suspended and the new system Tenex will be online.

IT Admin Jones gave his weekly report by phone: He explained the outage last week, Wi-Fi has been installed at Juvenile Detention, and Mat is working on Windows 10 upgrades throughout the county.

Buildings and Grounds Admin Thomsen gave his weekly report: Webb Nursery is working on the installation of the sprinkler system Dalry Electric is working on installing the lights in the courthouse lawn, will contact the City of Rupert to possibly get asphalt work done in the parking lot, discussed changing out the concrete pad with pavers to help with the sprinkler system efficiency. Board agreed to fund this project as funds are in the budget.

Ken Robirds did not attend today's meeting. Prosecutor Stevenson will contact him and reschedule.

Prosecutor Stevenson reviewed buy/sale agreement with the commissioners. Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve signing the real estate purchase agreement** for the property at 615 H Street and pay the earnest money to Title One with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Trent Bodily presented before the board to discuss the Dept. of Juvenile Corrections Memorandum of Agreement for clinical services. Commissioner Schenk moved to **approve signing the agreement** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve minutes from May 18th** with minor corrections with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to **approve claims and payroll** with second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

A grant was approved for a handicap-accessible restroom at Emerald Lake. Commissioner McClellan will take the lead for this project.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the Certificates of Residency presented with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Commissioner Koyle voted aye and Commissioner Schenk voted nay. Commissioner McClellan voted nay. Motion failed.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve the Certificate of Residency 101281582** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.
