



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

June 8, 2020

The meeting was opened at 8:30 AM with **The Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.**

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Schenk, Commissioner Koyle, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, Clerk Page and Deputy Clerk McCall.

Commissioner Schenk moved to deny the Certificate of Residency that was presented last week under a motion that failed with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

2020-21 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny as there was no interview so therefore, we do not know if medically indigent, obligated county, or last resource, with a second by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

2020-20 Commissioner Schenk moved to deny as not medically indigent and not the last resource with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to enter into the Board of Canvassers pursuant to IC 34-1205 with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried. Commissioner McClellan read the votes. Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the Canvass of the May 19, 2020 election counted on June 2, 2020, with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Commissioner Schenk moved to exit Board of Canvassers with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Assessor West presented the ERSI GIS maintenance contract for review. Commissioner Koyle moved to approve signing the ERSI GIS maintenance contract for the assessor's office with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the minutes for June 1 with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

IT Technician Wallin brought a Surface Pro for the Board to review. Commissioner Koyle moved to authorize the purchase of 4 Surface Pro tablets, along with the Microsoft Office program, keyboard and pen so they are prepared to work from home during the COVID pandemic and any future issues requiring the commissioners to work from home with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Lt. Cobbley entered the meeting to introduce the new hire for the sheriff's department, Deputy Taylor Rochford.

Chief Deputy Moore and Deputy Clerk Navarrete presented their plans for the annual Christmas party. Commissioner Koyle moved to approve up to \$2000.00 for the annual Christmas party to be held on December 4th and to be chaired by Chief Deputy Moore and Deputy Clerk Navarrete with a second voiced by Commissioner

Schenk. Motion carried. Commissioner Schenk will check with the Wilson Theater to see about the availability of that facility for the party.

Juvenile Detention Admin. Bodily presented the Juvenile Detention Center budget request for FY21 for Board review.

Juvenile Probation Admin Tate-Dennis presented the Office of Drug Policy Grant Awards for Board review. Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the signing of the Office of Drug Policy Grant awards with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried. She then presented the Juvenile Probation budget request for FY2021.

Commissioner Schenk moved to approve claims and payroll with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Public Defense Commission Admin Jared Ricks presented the Public Defense Commission quarterly report by phone, no information on grant application at this time, and entertained questions from Commissioners.

Sheriff Snarr presented the FY21 budget requests for the Sheriff's Department, E911, Communications and Waterways Department.

Clerk's Report:

Clerk Page presented her weekly report: discussed Minidoka Museum insurance coverage; some office furniture has been donated to Minidoka County.

Correspondence: Thank you letter from Judge Bollar; letter from Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Re: Idaho Power Hells Canyon.

Prosecutor Stevenson reported on his review of the Museum Memorandum of Understanding.


Commissioner McClellan had nothing to report.
