



## MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

June 17, 2019

The meeting was opened at 8:05 AM with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Clerk Page.

Buildings & Grounds Admin. Thomson presented before the Board to voice a **building and maintenance update**.

There were no **applications for county aid** to present before the Board.

Amber Prewitt, Misd. Probation Admin., presented before the Board to request approval to advertised for a **full-time position** instead of a part-time position. According to Commissioner McClellan this request had previously been approved by the jail executive board to bring forth to both Boards of Commissioners. Commissioner Schenk moved to have adult misdemeanor move a part-time position to a full-time position with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved that we pay the **claims and payroll** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the **designated authorized agent for unemployment insurance tax benefits which authorized Employee's Advocates, LLC to be the designated agent** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the **minutes** for June 10, 2019, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

### **Clerk reports:**

Clerk Page spoke of the Recorder's Office freebies that are offered to certain entities. She stated that she was going to charge people who state that they represent those entities unless the administrator of such entity calls and states that the person is working on behalf of the entity and that they are aware of the request. This will help the entity from being charged by the third party for documents that the third party did not pay for.

Clerk Page also spoke of the recent bill that was received for the medical insurance deductible buydown. This fiscal year we have paid over \$90,000, leaving a balance in the fund of a little over \$105,000. She reported that a change will have to be made before the fund goes broke.

Tom Murphy, Minidoka Memorial Hospital, called to reschedule presentation of the hospital strategic plan.

### **PUBLIC HEARING CONTINUATION OF THE FLOOD PLAIN ORDINANCE from June 3, 2019**

Chairman McClellan opened the hearing at 10:01 AM noticing that no members of the public were present. Brett Stephens gave a recommendation and pointed out that not the whole ordinance is applicable to our county.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve Title 8 Chapter 8 Flood Damage Protection District of the Minidoka County Ordinance with the changes that have been put in. A second to the motion was voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Commissioner McClellan called for discussion, heard none, called for a vote. All voted aye. Motion carried.

**Commissioner reports** were given.

Gus Bringelson, Anne Schenk, Audrey Neiwert, and Jim Grisenti, presented the **Minidoka County Historical Society budget request**.

Assessor West presented before the Board to discuss the **Application for Ag Exempt Parcels of Land 5 Contiguous Acres or Less** received. Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the Application for Agricultural Exemption for RP10S23E077756 with the market value of \$16,478 and an exemption value of \$4,290 with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.


The Board recessed for lunch at 11:45 AM.

The Board returned to session at 1:00 PM.


The following reviewed their budget requests:
