July 6, 2020

The meeting was opened at 8: 30 a.m. with The Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecutor Goodman, Clerk Page and Deputy Clerk McCall. Commissioner Koyle excused.

Covid-19 Discussion: Juvenile Detention Admin Bodily reported that an employee was exposed and will be tested.

Weed Superintendent Reid Smith reported on the weed issue at Lake Walcott. The main problem is on federal land owned by Fish and Wildlife and he has not been able to contact anyone. Board asked him to follow up with Cassia County on obtaining chemical.

Clerk Page did not have anything to report.


Commissioners gave their weekly reports.
