

Minutes
Mini-Cassia Board of Juvenile Probation
July 9, 2019

Commissioner Searle welcomed all at 7:30 AM.

Present: Commissioner Searle, Juvenile Detention Administrator Bodily, Sheriff Snarr, Sheriff Heward, Clerk Larsen, Clerk Page, Judge Hodges, Juvenile Probation Administrator Dixie Tate-Dennis, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Idaho Juvenile Justice Commission District Liaison Renee Waite, Prosecuting Attorney Abenroth, and Commissioner Koyle.

Prosecutor Stevenson moved with a second from Sheriff Snarr to approve the minutes of June 11, 2019. Motion carried.

Judge Hodges reported that there were few kids over the 4th of July. Discussion took place regarding: shackles in the courtroom with intent while in the court while the judge is present, leaving decision ultimately up to the judge; discretionary time; medication training; youth mental health first aid; and re-entry.

Juvenile Probation Admin. Tate-Dennis reported on WILD, night visits, and intense cases. She also requested permission to offer employment to one of the three to be interviewed. Prosecutor Stevenson moved to approve with a second voiced by Sheriff Heward to hire the better out of Joy Barron, Emily Peterman, and Brookie Stamper after their interviews. Motion carried.

IJJC District Liaison Waite reported on: district numbers; juvenile justice council and DVD's on Broken Pieces; crossover youth project to help identify kids before they enter justice system; and Rule 16 and Rule 19.

Clerk Larsen spoke on the Administrative Order that came through on juvenile probation of not more than the maximum fee to be used exclusively for the program.

Juvenile Detention Admin. Bodily reported on numbers in detention and that he would like to be authorized to utilize pets for emotional therapy in the facility, specifically a dog.

Sheriff Snarr moved to adjourn with a second voiced by Sheriff Heward. Motion carried at 8:00 AM.
