



## MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

July 13, 2020

The meeting was opened with the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer at 8:24 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, Clerk Page and Deputy Clerk McCall.

Others present: Al Albrecht, Zack Lanier with Farm Bureau.

Commissioner Schenk moved to **approve claims** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

2020-14 Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the appeal with a reimbursement of \$25.00 per month and ½ of tax returns with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to enter into Board of Equalization as per IC 63-501 with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Commissioner Schenk moved to rescind the previous decision to uphold the assessor's valuation on RP09S23E274800 and PP09S23E274800 based on a miscommunication with Amalgamated Sugar and further information being presented with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Commissioner Koyle moved to authorize Clerk Page to send a letter to the State Tax Commission to request an extension until July 30th in order to allow more time to receive additional information with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried. Commissioner Schenk moved to exit Board of Equalization with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

IT Admin Jones gave his weekly update via telephone.

Buildings and Maintenance Admin Thomson gave his weekly update, presented information on parking lot repair and presented a bid for installation of a handicap ramp and sidewalk for new building.

Prosecutor Stevenson presented information from the Robirds as they were unable to attend today's meeting. Nothing more has been done but said someone will be out there today to start working on the weed problem. Commissioners will revisit next week.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve six alcoholic beverage licenses** as presented: Walmart, Inc., TAG Inc., Stevo's LLC, Don and DeeAnn Garner, El Caporal, Inc. Ridley's Family Markets, Inc., with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve 5 Certificates of Residency and deny 1 Certificate of Residency** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Clerk Page reported on the CARES Act reimbursement for COVID-19. Masks that were ordered have all been delivered and plans are being made for the upcoming November election to help with possible congestion.

Commissioner Schenk moved to **approve the Public Defense Commission grant supplement** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Board reviewed IC 63-602NN property exempt from taxation statute.

Minidoka Soil and Water Conservation District Chair Brian Kossman presented their annual budget request for FY21.

Assessor West presented before the Board information on motor vehicles administrative fees and the need for an increase.

SIED Director Connie Stopher presented the quarterly report by Zoom.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve the minutes of June 29, July 1, and July 6** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Board reviewed the monthly Veteran Service Officer Report.

Board reviewed correspondence.

No commissioner reports given today.


Board spent afternoon working on budget details.
