



## MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

July 20, 2020

The meeting was opened with the recital of **The Pledge of Allegiance** at 8:30 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Clerk Page.

### **Indigent Applications:**

2020-02 Commissioner Schenk moved to approve dates of service up to December 14, 2019, with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried. As applicant is deceased there was no reimbursement ordered.

Commissioner Schenk moved to approve **claims and payroll** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the **minutes of July 13, 2020**, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Discussion of **Covid-19** took place regarding updates from the Board and Clerk.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the **Alcoholic Beverage License Applications** with a second voiced Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

The Board did not **ratify the award agreement** for Emerald Lake as there was not a copy of the document in front them to view. This ratification request was continued to next week.

The next Board of Equalization dates for appeals are scheduled for July 27<sup>th</sup> at 11 AM and if necessary, July 30<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 AM.

Tom and Ken Robirds presented before the Board to discuss and advise of their plans for the **property**. Tom indicated they are preparing to file a lawsuit against the County. They think they may have the property sold. Ken stated they have it cleaned up quite a bit. The Robirds would like notification as to when County is going to enter the property so that there is plenty of recording.

Bill Jones reported on **IT issues**. Tye Thomson reported on **building maintenance and projects** regarding COVID requirements. Thomson also discussed landscape and sidewalk issues with the newly acquired building. Commissioner Koyle discussed the look of the handicapped signage in the front of the courthouse.

Juvenile Detention Admin. Trent Bodily presented before the Board to ask for **approval and signing of a food service contract with Thomas Management**. Commissioner Schenk moved to approve and sign the updated contract for food service with Thomas Management with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Effective date is July 1, 2020.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve **Resolution 2020-7-20 to destroy public records** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

**Correspondence** was distributed from Bureau of Land Management, GEM Plan, and Mini-Cassia Commerce Authority.

Discussion of **title company contracts** took place. Clerk Page will obtain copies of the surrounding counties contracts.

11:10 AM Laurie Poulton of Cassia Regional Medical Center presented for a scheduled **indigent appeal hearing** on case number 2020-08. The applicant was not present and therefore, on behalf of the hospital, Ms. Poulton will withdraw the appeal.
