The meeting was opened at 9:00 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Schenk, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Welfare Director Dockstader. Commissioner Koyle was present at 9:16 AM.

Commissioner Schenk moved to enter into executive session pursuant to I.C. 74-206 (1) (d) with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Commissioner McClellan voiced for a roll call vote. Commissioner Schenk voted aye and Commissioner McClellan voted aye. Motion carried.


**2019-18:** The applicant was present for this meeting. The items in question were last resource and medical indigency. The applicant was asked to present the full 2018 tax return from her father's LLC, and a letter from her doctor stating she is not able to work. The Board chose to wait in the amount of 45 days or sooner for the applicant to present these items. At the end of the 45 days, the Board will make a decision. Commissioner Koyle entertained a motion to exit executive session with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk Motion carried.

**2019-36:** This case was called to hearing at 10:01 AM. The appellant and applicant were not present. Minidoka County received a call from a "friend" of the applicant stating that he was ill and not able to attend. Commissioner McClellan entertained for a motion. Commissioner Schenk moved to deny the application as the appellant did not show and no new information was presented to the Board. Commissioner Koyle seconded and the motion was carried.
