

MINUTES
Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center Committee Meeting
July 26, 2022
8:00 A.M.

The meeting was called to order by Prosecutor Stevenson at 8:01 A.M.

Minidoka County representatives present were: Commissioner McClellan, Sheriff Pinther, and Prosecutor Stevenson.

Cassia County representatives present were: Commissioner Searle, Prosecutor Larson, and Undersheriff Thompson.

Others present were: Cassia County Deputy Clerk Wallace, Director Renz, Director Prewitt, JDC Director Bodily, Minidoka Deputy Clerk Ramsey, Cassia Admin. McMurray, and Minidoka County Clerk Page.

Commissioner McClellan **moved to approve the minutes of July 12, 2022**, with a second voiced by Commissioner Searle. Motion carried.

Criminal Justice Center – Director Renz

Director Renz reported that there are 153 in custody: 46 Cassia, 48 Minidoka, 44 IDOC, 12 US Marshals, and 2 Twin Falls, which makes 58 beds rented. He reported that they still have 3 open positions. Commissioner Searle **moved to conditionally approve Heather McCormick**, with a second voiced by Undersheriff Thompson.

Discussion on how the jail medical will be paid in FY23 with indigent going away.

Adult Misdemeanor Probation – Director Prewitt

Director Prewitt reported that they have 1002 active probationers with 362 on pretrial release. She has a meeting next month with Averhealth regarding the transition.

Juvenile Detention Center – Director Bodily

Director Bodily reported that they have 4 residents, 3 Minidoka and 1 Cassia.

Undersheriff **Thompson moved to hire Mattie Jendresen for the nurse position**, with a second voiced by Commissioner Searle. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the installation of a new generator.

Criminal Justice Center Budget – Clerk Larsen

Deputy Clerk Wallace reported that at 81% of the year gone: Misdemeanor Probation expenditures are at 73% and revenues are good; jail expenditures are at 78% and revenue is at 72.66%; \$211,000.00 revenue for May and June is still out.; trust balance is at **\$404,115.23-**.
