



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

July 27, 2020

The meeting was opened with the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer at 8:30 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, Clerk Page, and Deputy Clerk McCall.

Application for County Aid:

2020-29 Commissioner Schenk moved to deny as applicant is not medically indigent and we are not the last resource with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion Carried.

Sheriff Snarr presented the 2020-21 School Resource Officer contract for approval. Commissioner Schenk moved to **approve the School Resource Officer contract** commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30th 2022, with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Lt. Cobbley presented the Idaho Dept. of Parks and Recreation Grant Agreement Form for approval. Commissioner Koyle moved to **ratify the Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation Grant agreement** form with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to **approve claims** as presented with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to **approve the minutes from July 20** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

COVID-19 discussion: Clerk Page reported that we were reimbursed for everything that was submitted for the CARES Act and have been preapproved for a thermal imaging unit, speaker intercom units, and a cooler for the coroner.

Buildings and Grounds Admin Thomson gave his weekly update. He presented bids for French drains and inquired about porta-potties for Emerald Lake. Board agreed park needed facilities.
