



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

July 29, 2021

The meeting was opened with the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer at 9:02 A.M.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner Schenk, Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Clerk Page, Deputy Clerk Ramsey and Deputy Clerk McCall.

Public present: Laurie Welch and Pat Sutphin, representing the Times News and staff from KMVT.

Commissioners began interviewing Undersheriff Pinther, the candidate for the Sheriff's position from the list of candidates received from the Minidoka County Republican Party. Undersheriff Pinther answered their questions in depth and shared his vision for the sheriff's department going forward.

Commissioner McClellan thanked Judge Brody, the employees from the sheriff's department, other department employees and elected officials for coming in to support Undersheriff Pinther.

Commissioner McClellan called for a motion to appoint Dave Pinther as the new Minidoka County Sheriff.

Commissioner Koyle moved to appoint Dave Pinther as the new Minidoka County Sheriff effective August 1, 2021 with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner McClellan commenced with the swearing in of Dave Pinther as the newly appointed Minidoka County Sheriff effective August 1, 2021.

Undersheriff Pinther thanked everyone for their support.

Commissioners met briefly with IT Admin Jones to discuss budget. Clerk Page stated that she will have her official recommendations to the Commissioners by August 2.
