Re: 2019 City of Heyburn Mayoral Recount

Dear Ms. Page:

Pursuant to Title 34, Chapter 23, of the Idaho Code, on Wednesday, December 11, 2019, I conducted a recount of the votes cast for the City of Heyburn mayoral election.

Cleo Gallegos had requested the recount. Canvass totals from the election indicated Ms. Gallegos had received 184 votes and Mark Rosa had received 199 votes. I began the recount at approximately 10 a.m. MST. The entire recount was conducted in plain view of both Ms. Gallegos and Mr. Rosa. I confirmed the numbers on the seals of the bags containing the impounded ballots matched the numbers listed on the property receipt from election night. Ms. Gallegos and Mr. Rosa confirmed that no impounded ballots remained in the ballot bags. The number of votes received by both candidates during the recount matched the canvass totals from election night. The recount result did not change the outcome of the election and the number of votes received by both candidates remained the same. After all votes had been counted, I declared Mr. Rosa the winner of the election and ended the recount.
