**Deadlines for May 2020 Election**

The following deadlines apply to the **May 19, 2020** Primary Election:

**May 19, 2020, 8p.m.**-Deadline to register to vote online or in person.

**May 19, 2020, 8p.m.**-Deadline for county clerk to receive a request for an absentee ballot by mail, online, or in person.

**June 2, 2020, 8p.m.**-Deadline for absentee ballots to be received by the county clerk.

**June 2, 2020, 9p.m.** Mountain Standard Time-Earliest time for results to be posted.

**August 25, 2020 (Consolidated Election – If needed)**

**November 3, 2020 (General Election)**
