QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 331, Minidoka, Cassia, Jerome and Lincoln Counties, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,250,000) each year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2024, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating schools of the District; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 16, 2021?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$122.93 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that will expire on June 30, 2022 and that currently costs \$122.93 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is not expected to change.
