

## MINIDOKA COUNTY NOTICE OF ELECTION

Pursuant to Idaho Code §34-1406, public notice is hereby given that the following **Primary Election** will be held on **May 19, 2020**.

In order to keep Idahoans safe amid a growing global health pandemic and protect their right to vote, Idahoans will vote in the May primary exclusively from home using absentee ballots. If you want to vote in the election, you will need to request your ballot online at [idahovotes.gov](http://idahovotes.gov) or contact your Minidoka County Elections office.

### ALL POLLING LOCATIONS WILL BE CLOSED

Voters who have accessibility concerns should contact Minidoka County Elections office to discuss what accommodations can be made available at 208-436-9511.

The following deadlines apply to the **May 19, 2020** Primary Election:

**May 19, 2020, 8p.m.**-Deadline to register to vote online or in person.

**May 19, 2020, 8p.m.**-Deadline for county clerk to receive a request for an absentee ballot by mail, online, or in person.

**June 2, 2020, 8p.m.**-Deadline for absentee ballots to be received by the county clerk.

**June 2, 2020, 9p.m.** Mountain Standard Time-Earliest time for results to be posted.
